



TRAVELLING BY CAR

Coming from Dublin City

Head northbound to Fairview, and at the end of Fairview Park you can go one of two routes:

1. From Fairview, keep straight out along the Clontarf (Coast) Road. Pass the wooden bridge on your right after Clontarf and then pass the next main entrance on your right ("Causeway") onto the Bull Island (ie at the end of St Annes Park, which will be on your left). Having passed the junction with Causeway, take the left at the next traffic lights (c.1 km later). This left turn is a sharp turn and then Shieling Square is c.700 metres further on your left hand side.
2. Take the Howth Road from Fairview (ie left at the Church opposite Westwood Fitness Centre) then keep straight until you come to Raheny village. Go straight through Raheny village (you will see a church on your left in the village) and Shieling Square is c.700 metres further on, on your right hand side.

Coming from Howth/Sutton

Travelling southbound, with the sea on your left, pass the Texaco Station (c.2.5 km / c.1.5 miles after Sutton Cross), then go right at the second set of traffic lights. Shieling Square will be c.700 metres further on your left hand side, just after the Topaz Station.

TRAVELLING BY DART

Take a right when exiting Raheny DART Station, and at the traffic lights go left. Shieling Square is c.700 metres further, on your right hand side.

TRAVELLING BY BUS

Bus numbers 31, 31B, 31N, 32A and 32B all travel from the city centre (departs Eden Quay and opposite Connolly Station). The bus stop opposite Shieling Square is the third stop after Raheny village. To return, there is a seated bus stop immediately outside the gates.

TRAVELLING BY CAR

Coming from Dublin City

Coming from Howth/Sutton

TRAVELLING BY DART

Take a right when exiting Raheny DART Station, and at the traffic lights go left. Shieling Square is c.700 metres further, on your right hand side.

TRAVELLING BY BUS

Bus numbers 31, 31B, 31N, 32A and 32B all travel from the city centre (departs Eden Quay and opposite Connolly Station). The bus stop opposite Shieling Square is the third stop after Raheny village. To return, there is a seated bus stop immediately outside the gates.
